User Authentication – LDAP and Kerberos

To gain access to Xerox® WorkCentre 6605 services, enter your network credentials on the control panel at the device. Once this information is authenticated using either LDAP and/or Kerberos, you are granted access to the services on the device. This feature also includes support for alphanumeric and special characters for user name and password and automatic retrieval of the logged on users' Scan to Email "from" address.

Convenience Authentication

The Xerox® WorkCentre 6605, with the Convenience Authentication feature, provides a unique combination of convenience and security. Select USB proximity readers or magnetic stripe readers can be utilized for user authentication to control access to device functions and implement Pull Print workflows. The Pull Print workflow protects sensitive information by allowing you to print documents using a print driver connected to a secure Pull Print Server. The document will not print until you successfully authenticate at the device.

Scanning to Mac

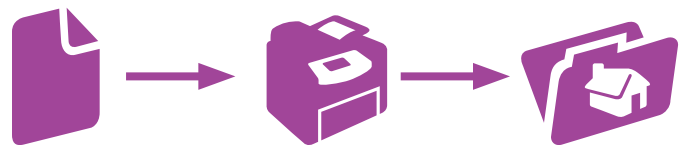
The Scan to Network update has added support for current versions of Apple® Mac® Operating Systems. This allows transfer of scanned documents over your network directly to a host server or computer via SMB running Mac OS® 10.7, 10.8 or 10.9.

Fax Forward to Email without Local Print

Allows you to configure Fax Forwarding to Email without requiring a copy of the fax to be printed at the device (currently the device does not allow you to disable the local print).

Scan to Home Directory

Scan to Home allows you to scan documents to the home folder defined in your Active Directory profile. After successfully logging in, you are automatically given the option to scan to your home folder using the Scan to Home template. Scan to Home is available when LDAP is configured as the authentication type.
